

*Devotional for Each Day of the Week*

**Sunday:** “But God shall shoot at them *with* an arrow; suddenly they shall be wounded.”—Psalm 64:7.

**Praise God** for being your great defender!

**Monday:** “. . . saying: *‘I will declare Your name to My brethren; In the midst of the assembly I will sing praise to You.’*”—Hebrews 2:12.

**Pray** for a willingness and courage to declare the name of the Lord not only among the unsaved, but among the saved as well.

**Tuesday:** “And again: *‘I will put My trust in Him.’* And again: *‘Here am I and the children whom God has given Me.’*”—Hebrews 2:13.

**Pray** for the confidence of knowing that Christ is trustworthy and the governor of salvation. **Pray** for Lafayette (Ind.) Reformed Presbyterian Church, pastored by Keith Evans.

**Wednesday:** “Inasmuch then as the children have partaken of flesh and blood, He Himself likewise shared in the same, that through death He might destroy him who had the power of death, that is, the devil.”—Hebrews 2:14.

**Pray** that you would be thankful for the sacrifice Christ made in putting on human flesh in order to effect salvation, and that your family and friends would understand this gospel message. **Pray** for Marion (Ind.) Reformed Presbyterian Church, pastored by Jason Camery; **pray** that the congregation would have an impact on its community, and also that it would soon be able to purchase a church building of its own.

**Thursday:** “. . . and release those who through fear of death were all their lifetime subject to bondage.”—Hebrews 2:15.

**Pray** for those around you to whom you witness, that they would be freed from their enslavement to sin. **Pray** for Scotland, that that land which is covenanted to be the Lord’s would repent and turn again to Him.

**Friday:** “For indeed He does not give aid to angels, but He does give aid to the seed of Abraham.”—Hebrews 2:16.

**Praise God** for His constant aid to the elect. **Pray** for our brothers and sisters in China, as they are in need of God’s care and protection.

**Saturday:** “Therefore, in all things He had to be made like *His* brethren, that He might be a merciful and faithful High Priest in things *pertaining* to God, to make propitiation for the sins of the people.”—Hebrews 2:17.

**Give praise to Christ** that He understands every pain and every temptation that you endure, because He endured them long before you. **Pray** for your pastor, that he would be encouraged in the faith, prepare a faithful message each week, and preach it with power and love. **Pray** that many people would come to church tomorrow, and that those who need salvation would be saved.
