### Scripture Memory and Catechism Questions & Answers

**“But as many as received him, to them gave he power to become the sons of God, even to them that believe on his name.”—John 1:12.**

**Q. 24. How doth Christ execute the office of a prophet?**

**A. Christ executeth the office of a prophet, in revealing to us, by his word and Spirit, the will of God for our salvation.**

**Q. 25. How doth Christ execute the office of a priest?**

**A. Christ executeth the office of a priest, in his once offering up of himself a sacrifice to satisfy divine justice, and reconcile us to God; and in making continual intercession for us.**

**Q. 26. How doth Christ execute the office of a king?**

**A. Christ executeth the office of a king, in subduing us to himself, in ruling and defending us, and in restraining and conquering all his and our enemies.**
